They found Jesus too much for them.



Sometimes we do not give God a chance. We assume that if we allow God to come near, God will ask us to suffer. Yet Jesus came that we might have life and live it fully. Jesus wants to heal what is broken and free what is imprisoned, but fear keeps us from drawing near to Jesus. Like those of Jesus' native place, we find Jesus too much for us.

St. Benedict – July 11th

The expression, he died with his boots on, originally referred to someone who died unexpectedly (probably from a gunshot wound) who didn't even have time to take off his boots. In time, however, it has come to mean a person who never gives up on life.

St. Benedict built twelve monasteries; one, Mount Cassino, was rebuilt three times.

Under his rule, monasteries became sanctuaries of learning and hospitality in the Middle Ages. Without the monasteries to keep the light of learning lit, the Dark Ages would have been dark indeed.

St. Benedict's influence on monastic life was so great that his rule, or plan, for monks became the standard throughout Europe. Even today, many religious orders operate under the Rule of St. Benedict.

True to form, Benedict died with his boots on (more likely his sandals). Although he needed some support from his monks, he was standing in the chapel with his hands raised to heaven when he died.

Many of us fear old age. We worry that we will become a burden to our families and to ourselves. Although life doesn't come with guarantees, the saints encourage us not to worry what might or might not happen. They point out that even when we can no longer work physically, we can still perform spiritual labors, such as forgiving those who have hurt us, praying for others, and comforting the sorrowful.

News from the Diocese of St. Paul

From: College of Consultors.

These are decisions made carefully by College of Consultors during the meeting that took place on June 21st 2012 in Pastoral Center and Villa Shalom.

1. Fort Kent:

St. Joseph Rectory in Fort Kent will be closed as of August 15. Fort Kent will no longer have a resident priest and will be served from Bonnyville. This decision is just a final step what Bishop Luc Bouchard had decided for the future plan of the Parish of St. Joseph in Fort Kent before he left. On June 15, 2012 Fr. Peter had a meeting with St. Joseph Council in order to finalize this proposal plan. All members of Council were in favor with the decision. They have to meet Fr. Rene Realuyo, actual Pastor of Bonnyville for further arrangements.

2. Appointments:

- a) Father Thomas Dieu Nguyen will be assistant Pastor in Bonnyville, effective August 15, 2012
- b) Father Francis of Assisi Khai Phan will be assistant Pastor in Fort McMurray, effective August 15, 2012.
- c) Father Ambrose Umeohanna, smmm will be assistant Pastor in Westlock, effective August 15, 2012. The Diocese will pay his salary until the parish gets a final change of pastor expected at the end of November 2012.
- d) Father Casmir Muobike, smmm will move to Plamondon as administrator, effective August 15, 2012. Father Polycarp Chukwu, smm has been called to go back to his Congregation for a special mission at the end of August, 2012.
- e) Father Jose Chirappanath, cmi. will move to Lac la Biche as administrator, effective August 15, 2012
