Each of us is also called to work for justice and peace and to serve the needs of those around us. Poverty wears many faces: some have needs of the body , some have needs of the spirit. God calls us to serve them all.

St. Bonaventure– July 15th

Ever notice how most rich and famous people tend to marry other rich and famous people? A lot of reasons are postulated, among them that it’s easier for someone who is already famous to put up with the pressures of celebrity life.

Often the real reason is overlooked: people tend to fall in love with the people they associate with. As Mark Twain wryly put it, “familiarity breeds.” Since rich and famous folk tend to hang out with other rich and famous folk, it’s only natural that their lives would intertwine.

The same is true of saints. Not only do they tend to associate with each other, they also tend to influence each other. St. Bonaventure knew two of the greatest saints in the world: St. Francis of Assisi and St. Thomas Aquinas. When he was a young boy, St. Francis cured him of serious illness. Then, while he was studying at the University of Paris, he became friends with Thomas Aquinas. The two received their degrees of doctor of theology at the same time. Since we know they were friends, we can assume that the two great saints often talked and shared their faith. They became spiritual friends as well as social companions.

Talking about faith with a spiritual friend can be a great comfort.

Our friends can strengthen us in times of trial and encourage us in times of doubt. They can brighten our lives and make the path to spiritual maturity easier to walk.
