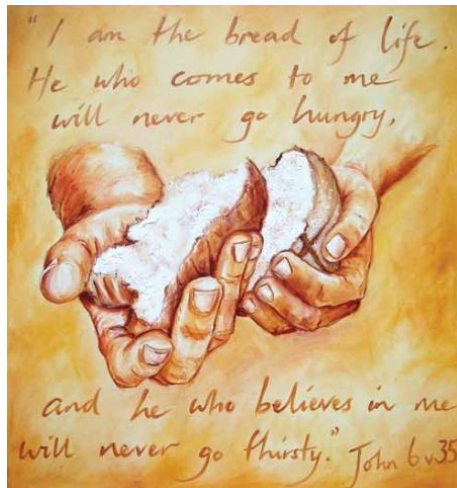

The Gospel reading today introduces the Bread of Life discourse. Just as God fed the Israelites.

St. Dominic– August 8th

The first half of the thirteenth century saw the rise of one of the most popular saints of all times—a man whose free spirit has captured hearts all over the world. That man was, of course, St. Francis of Assisi. During the same time period, another man was founding another religious order whose members would have an equally profound effect throughout the world. That man was St. Dominic.

Sometimes we get the mistaken notion religion is sort of a one-size-fits-all commodity. St. Dominic and St. Francis show that even when two individuals are called to the same work, they shape it according to their unique personalities and worldviews. Francis became the beggar who beguiled the world; Dominic became the preacher who taught it.

When we see someone with a wealth of spiritual knowledge, we may feel like we either have to catch up or give up. Had St. Dominic been able to foresee the immense popularity of St. Francis, he might easily have decided to give up—fortunately, he did not.

Similarly, we need to view those who do the same things we do not as our competitors, but as our companions. Legend has it that when Dominic met Francis he said, “If we hold together, no earthly power can withstand us.” Ever since the days of their founders, the Dominicans and Franciscans have offered Mass in each other’s churches as a sign of unity in a common goal.

A day at a time

God provided a mysterious food called *manna* for the Israelites during their time in the desert. However, they were told not to stockpile the manna, but to gather only what they needed for one day. Jesus told his disciples not to worry about tomorrow. He said, When you pray to your heavenly Father, you are to say, ‘Give us this day our daily bread.’
No matter how difficult life may be,
for those who trust in God
and who live a day at a time,
the manna falls every day.
