Needs Of The Church In Canada – September 30th

Each year the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB) is asked to speak out, give leadership, and provide guidelines for the faithful on a wide variety of topics. In order for our Bishops to be able to make sound judgements on modern topics, they must have the benefit of research and expert advice.

Research and gathering information require staff, time, and money. Through the yearly Bishops’ collection for the needs of the Church in Canada, an appeal is made to all Catholics to be generous in supporting the work of their Bishops at the Conference level.

Most dioceses have the collection at this time, but an individual diocese may choose another date.

We are asked to for the work of the Bishops and to participate in and cooperate with the various projects of the CCCB.

- d) **Fr. Peter Tran**, on behalf of the Diocese, appreciates the cooperation of Fr. Casimir Muobike,smmm, Fr. Jose Chirappanath,cmi, Fr. Ambrose Umeohanna,smmm, Fr. Thomas Dieu Nguyen and Fr. Francis of Assisi Khai Phan, in accepting their appointments that became effective on August 15, 2012.
 - e) **Fr. Faustin Pita-Pita**, originally from the Congo, has an Italian Citizenship now. He will reside at Villa Shalom and will assist at the Cathedral and possibly in Bonnyville at French Masses when needed.

THE RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)

RCIA assists those adults wishing to learn more about the Catholic Church. It is open to unbaptized adults, baptized Catholics who have not received the Initiation sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation.

Sessions will be held October through May, once a week in the evenings from 7 - 8:30 PM in the Rectory Downstairs. The program is defined by four periods of formation each marked by the celebration of liturgical rites in the parish.

Inquiry – A time for asking questions, sharing stories, awakening our faith, and becoming familiar with the life of the parish.

Catechumenate – A time for the deepening of faith and conversion and for passing on of Catholic tradition. It is a period of training and apprenticeship in the Christian way of life. A discussion of the Liturgy of the Word for the Sunday masses is scheduled weekly.

Purification and Enlightenment – A time when the parish joins with the Elect in prayer, fasting, and works of charity in preparation for Easter Vigil when the Elect may receive the Sacraments of Initiation – Baptism (for those who have never been baptized), Confirmation, and Eucharist..

Mystagogia – A time when the newly initiated, referred to as neophytes, reflect on their experience and begin to participate more fully in the sacramental life of the parish and in Christian service.

If you are interested or you know someone who may be interested, please talk to them. You can talk to fr. Ignacy at any time. Our first opening/information session will be on October 10th at 7:00 pm Rectory Downstairs.
