The Lord is coming soon.

As we come near to the end of this liturgical year, we are reminded that the end is coming soon. Our Catechism reminds us: *Since the Ascension Christ's coming in glory has been imminent, even though 'it is not for you to know times or seasons which the father has fixed by his own authority'* (673). As we gather to worship

this day, may we always be prepared for the coming of the Lord.

St. Cecilia – November 22nd

St. Cecilia is one of those saints who have been honored since the beginning of the church but of whom nothing concrete is known. Her legends are charming but totally unreliable. For instance, she is said to have been given in marriage to a non-Christian by the name of Valerian. She told her husband she was guarded by an angel and if he would consent to be baptized, he could see the angel, too. Valerian was and did, immediately becoming as ardent a Christian as was his wife.

Perhaps because she listened to the voices of angels, St. Cecilia is honored as the patron of music, musicians, and poetry.

Poetry is one of those things we often feel guilty about not liking. While most people would freely profess to loving poetry, you don't see many books of poetry on the best-seller list. And unless you frequent the company of love-struck college students, you probably won't hear much poetry quoted in everyday life.

If you haven't read any poetry since you had to when you were in school, maybe it's time to pick it up again. As William Wordsworth wrote, "Poetry is the breath and finer spirit of all knowledge; it is the impassioned expression which is in the countenance of all Science." If you remember liking one poet even a little bit, go back and read some of his or her works. If you don't have a clue where to begin, you might consider asking St. Cecilia to help you. Who knows, you may discover you're a poet...and didn't know it!
