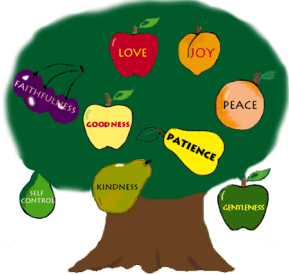
Marriage/Wedding:

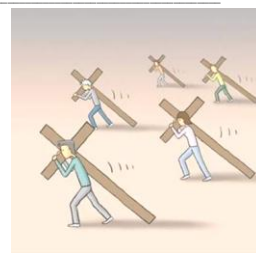
The Knights of Columbus 2013 memberships are now due. You can put the money in an envelope and label it Knights of Columbus and it can be placed in the collection basket at the church.
