## Month of the Sacred Heart



The Month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart. This year the Feast of the Sacred Heart falls on June 7<sup>th</sup>. The Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus on the Friday following the second Sunday after Pentecost. In addition to the liturgical celebration, many devotional exercises are connected with the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Of all devotions, devotion to the Sacred Heart was, and remains, one of the most widespread and popular in the Church.

## First Friday Adoration

On the First Friday of June we will have an Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. There will be Mass at 8:30 am and the church will be open between throughout the day for adoration with the Blessed Sacrament exposed. Around 6:30 we will have a Rosary, and at 6:45 we will have devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus to conclude the adoration. Mass will follow at 7:00 pm.



There is a sign up sheet at the back of the church so that at least 2 people sign for each hour to make sure there is always someone present in the church with Blessed Sacrament exposed.

But we **invite everyone** to come during a day to spend some time with our Lord.
