Setting aside time to pray helps to ensure that Christ's peace reigns in our hearts and lives.

The fast-paced nature and rapid rate of change in today's world can serve as obstacles to experiencing peace and serenity in our lives. However, by following the example of Mary in today's Gospel by taking the time to pray each day and listen to Jesus, Christ's peace can reign in our lives and hearts no matter what obstacles we face.

St. Mary Magdalene – July 22

For centuries, Mary Magdalene has been identified with sinful woman who anointed Jesus's feet with perfume at the house of Simon, the Pharisee. What's more, sinful woman is often thought to have been a prostitute, Mary gets stuck with the label also. Yet there's no evidence that the Mary who lived in the town of Magdala and from whom Jesus cast out seven devils had anything to do with the woman "who was a sinner." Mary Magdalene was more likely to have been mentally ill or demonically possessed than she was to have been immoral.

Poor Mary is the victim of untruth in labeling. Over the centuries, more careful reading of Scripture has allowed us to know the truth about Mary Magdalene. She is now seen for what she really was, not what she was imagined to be.

We need to do the same for ourselves. We need to see ourselves for what we really are, not what someone else imagines us to be. Often we allow others to give us labels that may not be appropriate. One way to find out if you've been mislabeled is to listen for the words *always* and *never*. If the people around you tend to say, 'you always...' or 'you never...' you can be certain that untrue labeling is at work. Instead of accepting such mislabels without question, take the time to politely yet firmly point out the saying 'you never' and 'you always' are never true and are always a mistake!

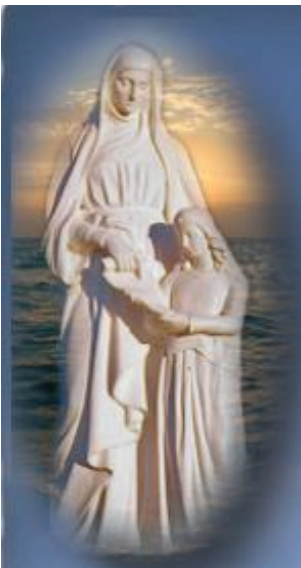
