## Developing a Safe Parish Community

The Diocese of St. Paul has developed a policy to ensure that our Parish Community is a safe place for all our parishioners, our volunteers, our staff, and our Church. Our safe Parish Community Committee will be responsible to ensure that the Diocesan Policy is implemented locally.

Everyone who volunteers or is an employee of the parish will be required to sign a safe parish pledge. Beside this, high risk ministries will have to submit letters of reference, submit a criminal record check, and attend an orientation session on “Developing a safe parish community”

This is to let you know what is coming and what we have to do while ministering in our parish.

We will let you know more next week’s bulletin. **To comply with the policy the High Risk Ministers are required to attend one of the following compulsory workshops in 2013.**
