Developing a Safe Parish Community

The Diocese of St. Paul has developed a policy to ensure that our Parish Community is a safe place for all our parishioners, our volunteers, our staff, and our Church. Our safe Parish Community Committee will be responsible to ensure that the Diocesan Policy is implemented locally.

Everyone who volunteers or is an employee of the parish will be required to sign a safe parish pledge. Beside this, high risk ministries will have to submit letters of reference, submit a criminal record check, and attend an orientation session on “Developing a safe parish community”

To comply with the policy the High Risk Ministers are required to attend a compulsory workshop in 2014. There will be a workshop taking place on Tuesday February 25th at 7:00 pm at St. Gabriel’s Parish In Athabasca. If you would like to attend please call Paula at 780-675-2411.
