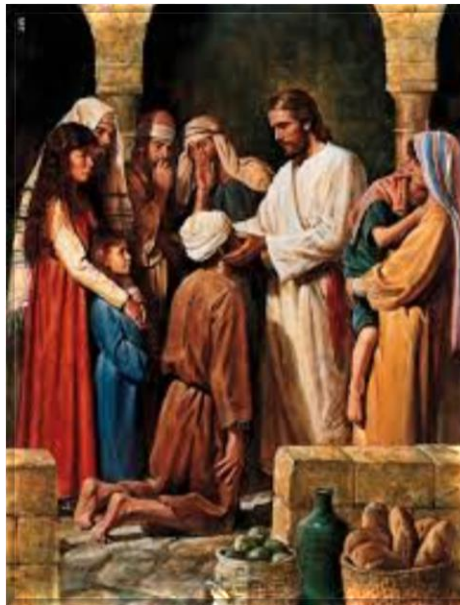

The grace of God allows us to see the world, ourselves, and our brothers and sisters in Christ through the eyes of faith. This is a never-ending journey which seeks to understand God and the love of Jesus Christ that is poured out on all creation. This is the key to making our presence in the world reflect the awesome power of God.

First Friday Adoration On the **First Friday of April** we will have a day of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. The church will be open between 9:00 am and 6:30 pm and everyone will be able to come for longer or shorter period of time to spend with Eucharistic Jesus. We begin with Mass at 8:30 am, then the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for Adoration and prayer. At the end of the day there will be a **Way of the Cross at 6:30 pm**, followed by **Mass at 7:00 pm**.

There is a sign up sheet at the back of the church so that at least 2 people sign for each hour to make sure there is always someone present in the church with Blessed Sacrament exposed.

We invite everyone to come during a day to spend some time with our Lord.

Confession We sincerely invite everyone to come for confession on April 3rd on our parish. For those who cannot make for that evening, there will be additional time on Friday, April 11th from 5:45 to 6:45 pm, followed by Way of the Cross at 7pm Please invite your loved one and those who really need to be touched by God's mercy to experience His loving care. Please also encourage and give chance to your children to meet merciful Lord.

Development and Peace 2014 The bishops of Canada endorse the Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace. Each Lent, in co-operation with other churches, they continue to bring the needs of the Third World before the people of our country and encourage all to respond to God's generosity by supporting the works of CCOOP.

On the 5th Sunday of Lent, a collection is taken up for developing countries. Christians are urged to share their goods with others and thus express in a concrete way their desire to come closer to God and all God's children as a result of their Lenten efforts. The offering should reflect the money saved through penitential fasting and set aside for God's people.

While the importance of this action for others should be emphasized, it should be kept within the framework of Lenten practice. External and social penance is encouraged by the Church and can be expressed through this collection.

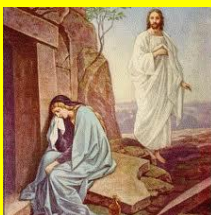
