On Saturday June 27, 2014 the first Saturday after St. Jean Baptiste Day, you are invited to take your walking stick and to join us on a 20 km walk from St. Emile Church in Legal to St. Jean Baptiste Parish in Morinville! It is an excellent opportunity to step aside from our busy lives and to enter a personal journey. Whether you are alone, with friends or family members, you are welcome to join us. Based on past experiences, a 20 kilometres walk may take between 6 and 8 hours, depending on your pace. It is not a race! Here is the plan:

8:15 AM Meeting at St. Emile Church in Legal.

8:30 AM Blessing from Father Ignacy and/or Father Brian

8:45 AM to 4:00 PM Walk from Legal to Morinville

3:00 PM to 5:00 PM As you come to St. Jean Baptiste Parish, the doors will be open to welcome you. Each pilgrim will receive a certificate to attest that they have completed their journey.

## First Friday Adoration

On the **First Friday of June** we will have a day of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. The church will be open between 9:00 am and 7:00 pm and everyone will be able to come for longer or shorter period of time to spend with Eucharistic Jesus. We begin with Mass at 8:30 am, then the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for Adoration and prayer till 7:00 pm. We will finish with the **Mass at 7:00 pm.**

There is a **sign up sheet at the back** of the church so that at least 2 people sign for each hour to make sure there is always someone present in the church with Blessed Sacrament exposed.



## What is Camp St. Louis?

It is a faith based camp experience that will last a lifetime. It is run by young adults, (Team) with Youth for Christ. During the week the team and campers participate in daily Mass, prayers, celebrating the sacraments,

and a better understanding of the Catholic faith. Outdoor activities include sports, singing, swimming, and nightly campfires. The camp can accommodate up to 80 campers including the counselors. Registration is on a first-come, first-serve basis. Camp St. Louis hosts kids from ages 8 to 14, and a counselor week.

11 year olds	can pick either the 10 or 12 year old week.
11 - 12 years old	- July 20 - 25 (Sunday to Friday)
8 - 9 years old	- Aug 4 - 8 short week (Monday to Friday)
13 - 14 years old	- Aug 10 - 15 (Sunday to Friday)

*Fun and Games:* Camp is loaded with activities such as swimming, hiking, volleyball, Frisbee, soccer, skits, "Capture the Flag," and other exciting games.

*Deepen your faith:* We celebrate the Mass almost everyday, listen to Talks, reflect on the life Christ, and participate in the sacrament of Reconciliation. We end each day by rejoicing and praising God through singing at Camp fire.
