Catholic worldwide are urged to pray for priests today on the **World Day of Prayer for Priests**. The day was begun by Pope John Paul II in 2002 with the objective of having all Catholic faithful join in prayer for the sanctification of priests. The World Day of Prayer for Priests coincides with the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

## **Family Life Conference Love One another**

First, was St. John Paul II, Charismatic pope of the people, who had special love for youth and family. He never stopped living his first words as our Holy Father, “Be not afraid!” He fearlessly taught and faithfully witnessed to truth. He humbly apologized to the world for the Catholic’s Church’s past failures and lack of charity. It was his encouragement for families to “become what you are” that was the impetus for CFM’s apostolate for families for the past 19 years.

Where St. John Paul II was the most traveled pope, Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI is the most prolific writer in defending traditional Catholic doctrine and values. He advocated a return to fundamental Christian values to counter the increased secularization of many Western countries. He views relativism’s denial of objective truth, and the denial of moral truth in particular, as the central problem of the 21<sup>st</sup> century. He taught the importance of both the Catholic Church and an understanding of God’s redemptive love.

Following these two intellectual giants, Pope Francis is intent on moving their message of truth from the head to the heart. He compels us to bring the tremendous gift of faith we have to the marginalized, larger majority of the world. We must evangelize with boldness, with mercy, with joy, and with love. In essence, to “LOVE ONE ANOTHER”.
