The St Paul Diocesan Youth Office is forming a group to attend World Youth Day 2016 in Krakow, Poland. World Youth Day is a very exciting opportunity to unite with young people from around the world in celebration of our catholic faith! The Diocese has already coordinated with the JMJ YOUTH Pilgrimages office and have developed a very exciting itinerary including a pilgrimage to follow in the footsteps of three very major polish saints: St. Maximillian Kolbe, St. Faustina and pope St. John Paul II! Our Pilgrimage will begin July 16, 2016 and end on August 5, 2016 after also having participated in a special retreat which will be organized and run by the Diocesan leaders in Holland!

World Youth Day is very exciting however, there is some urgency with which we speak because accommodations and space in our group are limited and it is important that we begin fundraising as a Diocese and as parishes immediately in order to spare as much expense to the pilgrims as well as to the parishes and communities who will be supporting our pilgrims. Therefore, if you are interested in attending WYD and will be between 18 and 35 years old by Aug. 2016, it is vital that you contact Erica to get a registration form and send it back as soon as possible! (We are also looking for chaperones. Call for more details) Registration costs \$100 and pilgrims will be required to provide monthly deposits of \$100 until a target of \$2,300 is reached. The remaining costs of \$2,323 per pilgrim will be fundraised on a personal, parish and Diocesan level. After having filled out and submitting the Commitment form, you will be given a Starter Package which will further outline details and explain World Youth Day. If you'd like the starter Package to help in your discernment, feel free to email, call or text Erica and ask for it.

96th Annual Pilgrimage 2014 August 14-15th Skaro Shrine

On Thursday August 15, there will be a special Mass with the Sacrament of the sick at 10:00 am followed by the blessing of religious articles and a Blessed Sacrament procession.

What is Camp St. Louis?



It is a faith based camp experience that will last a lifetime. It is run by young adults, (Team) with Youth for Christ. During the week the team and campers participate in daily Mass, prayers, celebrating the sacraments, and a better understanding of the Catholic faith. Outdoor activities include sports, singing, swimming, and nightly campfires. The camp can accommodate up to 80 campers including the counselors. Registration is on a first-come, first-serve basis. Camp St. Louis hosts kids from ages 8 to 14, and a counselor week.

Fun and Games: Camp is loaded with activities such as swimming, hiking, volleyball, Frisbee, soccer, skits, "Capture the Flag," and other exciting games.

Deepen your faith: We celebrate the Mass almost everyday, listen to Talks, reflect on the life Christ, and participate in the sacrament of Reconciliation. We end each day by rejoicing and praising God through singing at Camp fire.
