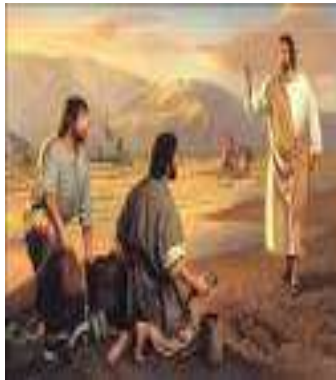

Focus of the Sunday Readings

We are to use our everyday actions and conversations to help attract others to Jesus.

Through their witness of Jesus as the Messiah, John the Baptist and Saint Andrew are instrumental to the world coming to know about Jesus and his mission on earth. By telling a friend or relative about Jesus, which is what these men did, we are continuing this work of evangelization today. In today's first reading, Eli teaches Samuel how to respond to God's call, and Samuel learns well.

The second reading teaches that our bodies are to be used by us to glorify God. In the Gospel, John the Baptist tells his followers that Jesus is the Messiah.

Through the 23 musical numbers of this original production, the audience connects with Mary as she grows from child, to wife, and mother. The importance of unity among Christians and the responsibility of the people of each parish to work for this unity should be emphasized throughout the week. All members of the parish should seek to have a deeper understanding of ecumenism.

World Day of Migrants and Refugees January 18

A World Day of Migrants and Refugees is observed in many places in solidarity with the World Refugee Day promoted by the United Nations and observed since 2001 on 20 June. This January observance was instituted by Pope Pius X in 1914. "The phenomenon of migration today is a providential opportunity for the proclamation of the Gospel in the contemporary world" (Pope Benedict XVI, 2012).
