The Pope's Pastoral Works – May 17

A disastrous flood or earthquake strikes a nation at the other end of the world. Immediately many countries rush in food, medicine, blankets, money, and trained people. Prominent among such aid is the financial help offered by the Holy Father to people in need. In the name of Catholicism everywhere, he displays Christ's love and compassion for those who suffer.

Each year at this time, Canadian Catholics are asked to give generously to this papal collection, which is passed on to the Holy father for his use among those stricken by natural disasters.

World Communications Day – May 17

Today Catholics are invited to reflect upon the media of social communication (films, radio, television, newspapers, audiovisuals) and how these influence our lives.

The media can promote values that lead to a more fully human society. The Church's ministry is twofold. The media can be used to help promote the Gospel. At the same time, as receivers of the materials presented by the media, the faithful have a duty to support and promote worthwhile presentations on media and reject those which promote values contrary to spiritual growth.

St. Rita Of Cascia - May 22nd - 'Saint of the Impossible'

When St. Rita of Cascia's husband was murdered, her two sons vowed to avenge his death. St. Rita prayed that they would die rather than commit murder. She got her wish. The boys contracted a fatal illness and died before they were able to act.

St. Rita got exactly what she prayed for, but fortunately for most of us, God gives us what we need, not what we think we want. Because we have limited insight and vision, we ask for what appears best at the time. God, on the other hand, sees what is best for eternity.

Let's say you interview for a job you really want. It's with a good company and has great benefits. You storm the gates of heaven, begging that you got the position. Then the letter comes: Thank you for your interest, but... You naturally feel disappointed and angry. Why didn't God let you have the job? Maybe the job wouldn't have lasted. Maybe God wants you to change careers. Maybe there would have been temptations that would have proven disastrous to your spiritual development if you had been given the position.

We probably will never know the answers to our questions, but at times like these, all we can do is trust that God has other plans in mind – plans that are always in our best interest.

The next time you don't get what you pray for, give thanks for having been protected from misjudgment and give thanks for the blessings you know will come.
