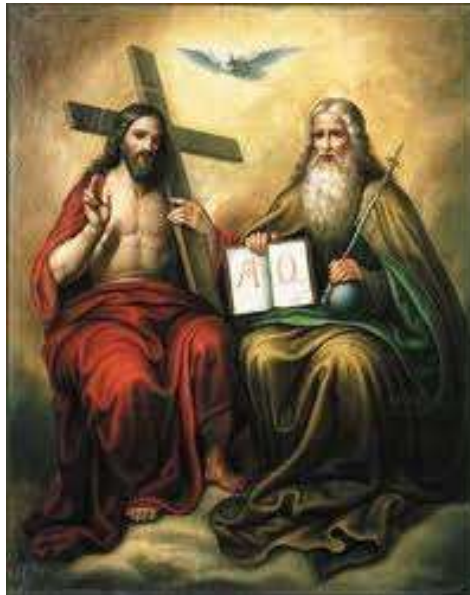

## St. Boniface – June 5<sup>th</sup>

St. Boniface was a leading figure in the Anglo-Saxon mission to the German parts of the Frankish Empire during the 8<sup>th</sup> century. He established the first organized Christianity in many parts of Germany. He is the patron saint of Germany, the first archbishop of Mainz and the “Apostle of the Germans”. He was killed in Frisia in 754, along with 52 others. His remains were returned to Fulda, where they rest in a sarcophagus which became a site of pilgrimage. Boniface is celebrated as a missionary; he is regarded as a unifier of Europe, and he is seen (mainly by Catholics) as a German national figure.
