Greater St. Albert Catholic Schools' 150th Anniversary Mass on the Hill

On June 11th, 2015, Greater St. Albert Catholic Schools is celebrating an outdoor Mass to commemorate the 150th anniversary of Catholic education in St. Albert.

Staff and students from across the School District will be gathering for this celebration. Parents and other communities, are also warmly invited. Over six thousand people are expected to be in attendance. Our main celebrants at Mass will be Archbishop Richard Smith of the Archdiocese of Edmonton, Bishop Paul Terrio of the Diocese of St. Paul, and Bishop David Motiuk of the Ukrainian Eparchy of Edmonton. Concelebrating with him will be Fr. Mike Dechant and our parish priests from St. Albert and Morinville.

The details are as follows: **Date:** Thursday June 11th, 2015

Time: 9:45 – 11:00 am

Place: The hill below the Greater St. Albert Catholic Schools' District Office on St. Vital Avenue, across the street from St. Albert Parish.

Please plan to arrive at least fifteen minutes beforehand, to allow enough time for you to be properly seated. Parents may join their children, who will be seated with their school on the grass. Or you may sit in a special section that is reserved for the public near the covered stage (to the east). There will be a pre-Mass program that includes music from our schools.

There will be no street parking immediately around the venue, as it has been reserved for over forty school buses. However, public parking will be available at St. Albert Catholic Church on St. Vital Avenue. Our 150th Anniversary Mass on the hill is an opportunity for us to recognize our rich history, to give thanks to God for all the blessings we have received, and to celebrate the strength in our community. What is Camp St. Louis?
