On August 14th the celebrations begins with: 6:30 pm – Reconciliation

Celiac Disease and Communion

We would like to address again the issue again and remind those who are interested to please contact the pastor or the parish office.

Although Church canon law requires that the host be made with wheat flour, which contains gluten, the Church makes it possible for most people with gluten intolerance to receive the Eucharist in a way that is not harmful to them. People with celiac disease or other forms of gluten intolerance have several options available to them: they may receive a small amount of a regular host; they may use a low-gluten host; or they may receive Holy Communion under the form of wine only. For those who cannot risk ingesting even a tiny bit of gluten, they can ask the priest to consecrate some wine in a separate chalice. Of course, a person who cannot consume a regular wheat host is always free to receive only the Precious Blood from the chalice; the Eucharistic Lord is entirely present in either the consecrated bread or wine

What is Camp St. Louis?



It is a faith based camp experience that will last a lifetime. It is run by young adults, (Team) with Youth for Christ. During the week the team and campers participate in daily Mass, prayers,

celebrating the sacraments, and a better understanding of the Catholic faith. Outdoor activities include sports, singing, swimming, and nightly campfires.
