*We are called to foster unity, peace and reconciliation in the world.*

Jesus, through his suffering and death upon the cross, won forgiveness for our sins and reconciled us to God the Father. He calls us to go forth to share God's love and forgiveness with others by seeking to foster unity, peace and healing in our workplaces, local community, among friends and family, and in our homes.

The first reading tells of the Israelites celebrating Passover when they entered the Promised Land. The second reading reminds us that we are called to work to foster unity and peace in the world. In the Gospel, Jesus tells the parable of the prodigal son, which reminds us that God loves us unconditionally and is ever-willing to forgive us.

### Share Lent Pilgrimage – Helping nuns serve their people in Bethlehem

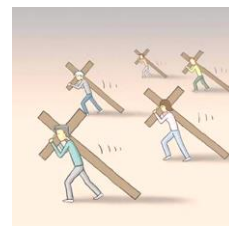

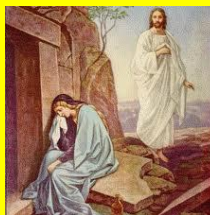
