## Focus of the Sunday Readings

*This week takes us from somber reflection to glorious rejoicing.*

We begin our holiest week of the year with blessed branches and processions. We recall the events that lead to another procession on Good Friday up the hill to Calvary. Because we know the rest of the story, we anticipate the glorious procession from the empty tomb to the announcement of the good news that Jesus had risen from the dead.

The first reading tells of the faithful servant of God being abused and beaten. The second reading reminds us that Jesus emptied himself and became one of us for the sake of our salvation. Today's Gospel reading recounts Jesus' passion and death, which defeated sin and evil and won forgiveness for our sins.
