Focus of the Sunday Readings

We give thanks to the Lord for the gift of life.

Life itself is a precious gift from God. With that gift comes the obligation to use what we have been given for the betterment of ourselves and others. To waste the talents that are uniquely ours is a loss that can never be recovered. We can praise the Lord with who we are and all that we are.

In today's first reading and in the Gospel, we hear two accounts of life being restored. Elijah pleaded with God to revive the widow's son, and Jesus was moved by pity for the grieving mother and restored her son's life. Paul explains to the Galatians that the source of his teaching is revelation from Jesus Christ.

Month of the Sacred Heart

The Month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart. The Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus on the Friday following the second Sunday after Pentecost. In addition to the liturgical celebration, many devotional exercises are connected with the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Of all devotions, devotion to the Sacred Heart was, and remains, one of the most widespread and popular in the Church.
