Focus of the Sunday Readings

God so loved the world that he gave his only Son.

The life and teachings of Jesus reveal to us that God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit are a community of persons who live together as one in a perfect unity of life and love with one another. As such, we are called to model our lives on the Most Holy Trinity – by seeking to give God glory in all we do and by living in love and unity with God and with one another.

In today's first reading from Exodus, the Lord revealed himself to Moses directly as kind, merciful and slow to anger. In the second reading, Saint Paul stresses to the Corinthians the importance of living in peace. The Gospel reminds us that *God so loved the world that he gave his only Son* so that all who believe in him might have eternal life.

Through simple signs of bread and wine, the profound gift of Jesus is made present to us.

The sign of unity in our faith life is the Eucharist. The living bread we receive at Communion sustains us and reminds us that Jesus is with us always. Let our humble belief in the Eucharist set a holy example to be followed.

In the first reading, Moses tells the people they must know hunger to appreciate the manna the Lord provided. In the second reading, Saint Paul professes faith in the Eucharist and calls believers to unity around the Eucharistic table. In the Gospel, Jesus creates controversy by proclaiming to be living bread come down from heaven, He says that all who eat this living bread shall live forever.

World Day of Prayer for Priests – June 23

Catholics worldwide are urged to pray for priests today on the World Day of Prayer for Priests. The day was begun by Saint John Paul II in 2002 with the objective of having all Catholic faithful join in prayer for the sanctification of priests. The World Day of Prayer for Priests coincides with the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.
