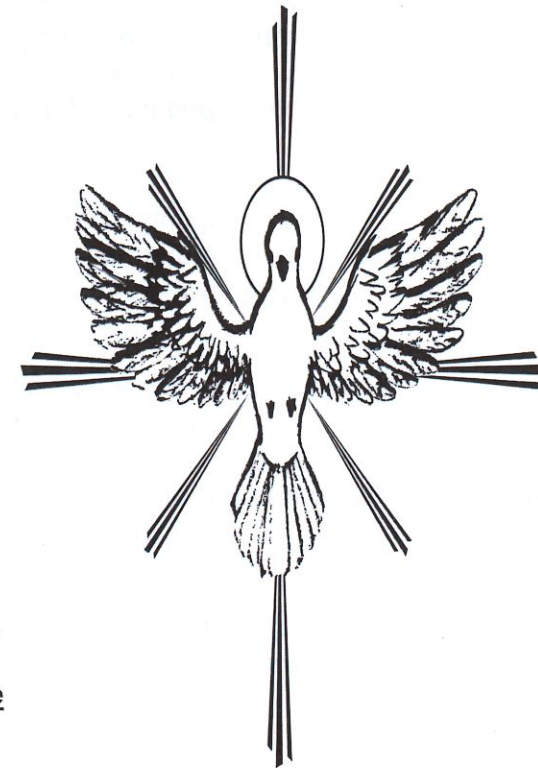

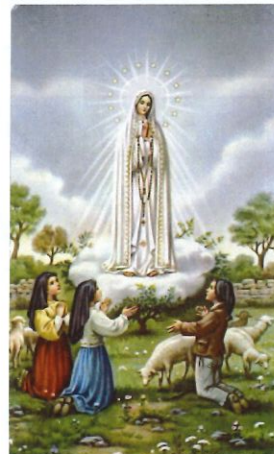
Consecration to the Blessed Virgin Mary of Fatima
